According to the Prince Edward Island Cattle Producers *Registration & Cattle Marketing Levies Order*

- “Buyer” means a person who purchases cattle from a producer and includes a producer, a drover, an auction and a processor
- Buyers shall deduct levy from the amount owing to the producer, remit that levy to the PEICP Office and provide the producer a document that shows number of cattle sold, levy deducted, buyer contact info and date.
- Where, in the ordinary course of business as a drover, a drover feeds or owns cattle for a period of not more than seven (7) days, the drover is deemed not to be a producer and is not liability to pay levy for that animal to PEICP.
